Last night in Middletown, Pete Andrews, 19, Concord, Mass. and Ken Elets, 21, Fort Wayne, Ind., trying to get cab back to SNCC office. Finally got white cab and were beaten by guy with cab driver. Police came and arrested two Yale guys-- on charge of assault and battery. Posted \$25 bond each and left town this morning in trial. Mike 2 JD men were in town and got the whole story (John Rosenberg and Robert Owen). Two white people present during incident said they would testify on behalf of two Yale guys. One was a 15 year old boy who was later arrested for loitering.
