An automatic cotton picker being used in the Mississippi Delta. Over 3,900 of these machines were used in the Delta this year. Each one displaces about 40 men, who, since they were unskilled cotton pickers, will not be able to find other jobs.

Negro citizens attempt to cast ballots in Greenwood in the Delta, Mississippi, August 1963. Note helmeted policemen photographing each of them as they enter the courthouse. The photographs will later be used to intimidate them, and perhaps to force them from their jobs or homes because they tried to vote.

Atlanta, Georgia, summer 1963. Several incidents of violence occurred against students attempting to integrate restaurants.
