now 2200 registered voters when they came into Danville-- now 4000 registered (about 800 during summer and 1200 during last most recent drive (during last few weeks)  
SCLC presently trying to take over movement  
Avon and others in local movement trying to get high school to walk out of school today- at about 12:30 or 1:30  
(because yesterday people were arrested in connection with lying on a bridge during the summer demonstrations-- because of sentences yesterday and because there has been no significant improvements in hiring, upgrading, etc.- city hospital is same as during the summer-- Howard Johnson's still pressing charges from summer; fed'l gov't has n't made any decision on charges from summer.

No bond money in Danville now so they don't know how long they'll have to be in jail.  
All property tied up in bonds from summer.

Avon will try to get out of jail within ten days if and when arrested (because of health)  
Mathew will try to stay out of jail.
