Her mother is a good friend of the only Negro in town on the 'blacklist' of the movement. Bobby hasn't been called to testify tomorrow. She has been in the movement for quite a while.

Packages and letters are being given to the people in jail. They haven't been able to visit Carol Merritt or Alma Bosley, however, because only relatives have been allowed in to see the girls.
