Cambridge, Maryland: Gloria Richardson

Gloria has announced demonstrations within ten days- if/ she goes to jail she'll need someone to come in to Cambridge to help-- she has heard that the klan is in town, but she doesn't know.

Office now open from 9am-12midnight--during demonstrations it will be a 24 hour office on two shifts.

Gloria wants us to send a telegram to Ekkkk Charles Evers re incident above on Jackson State Campus this morning - sign her name, saying that she feels that what he said to the students this morning was not in line with the protest movement--and that he isn't filling his brother's shoes, etc.
