Willie McKay, Bobbie Talbert \$500 bond pending appeal from April 14 arrest appeared before Judge J L Spencer yesterday. Both are Tougaloo students.

Network cameramen on hand again April 15 when two Negroes with tickets were also asked to leave. Police however did not make arrests - presumably because there was too much coverage.

Rev. Ed King contacted manager of Ice show in Cleveland and asked him to cancel remaining Jackson performances. Manager said it was too late for him to take any action because of a "binding contract" and he also refused to make a public statement

Tonight, April 16, Gershon Konditi, from Kenya, and Ray DeVogel, from Rochester, Minnesota (based at Tougaloo - don't know if students) had tickets for the white section. They were directed by police to colored window when they arrived, they went straight to colored door, were told white ticket no good, were finally turned away. Eli Hochstedler, white, from Nashville, Ind. & Marion Gillion (male, Bham Negro) arrested for breach of the peace after going through essentially the same procedure. Bond set \$500. Still in jail. (city jail.) Kondite had been wearing Kenyan dress, was insulted by parking attendants. He will protest to his embassy.
