Two white ministers, Rev. Alexander Stuart and Rev. Goddes Orman, were b eaten in Ekhhikk Danden, Alabama on Tuesday night. Rev. James Foster Reese witnessed the end of the assault- Reese! is the clerk of the Union Presbytery in the Gunden area.

Two white men broke into their hotel room (broke the door down). They had a pistol and a shot gun. The started shooting but didn't do too much damage because they were drunk. The t hen started beating the ministers and one received a broken arm, one a broke n leg. They then went cut and tore the ignition from the ministers' car so they had to hitch to Selma. They were treated in Selms by a Negro doctor, Dr. E.A. Maddox. The men were in Conden on normal eclesistical business, but evidently at a meeting of whites that night, the b elief was that they were part of a wave of clergy coming into the area to stir up trouble (possibly like the numbers of Horthern churchmen who have come into Mississipsi ). According to Knoxville College information office the two assailants were members of the Citizens' Council.

The sheriff has said that he will not arrest the assailants unless a warrant is signed. Frank Hines, Mational Presbytery, MC, says a warrant

is coming.
