Last night Sheriff Clark came by the Freedom House before they went to the mass meeting saying he had gotten a complaint that a white person was seen near the house with a walky talky (He John believes that he was implying that Eric Farnum, the white student from Raleigh working with the project, was the white man). ~~He~~ Sheriff Clark said that he wanted to know who everyone was 'in case their bodies were dragged out of the river' and gave ~~He~~ John Love and Eric two page forms with questions to fill out-- questions about name and address and about the organization they belonged to, questions re political attitudes (i.e. ever belonged to CP, etc). He did not force either John or Eric to answer any of the questions. He didn't request information from the other staff people because he said he knew them.

At the mass meeting there were about 25 posse. // 2 plainclothesmen were sent into the meeting and took pictures of people in the rally with small ~~kkkk~~ cameras. There were two visitors from the Netherlands who were questioned by police. They were an exchange student at Harvard and his wife.

There will be a student meeting tonight for work on the Freedom Day on July 6. There has been some discussion with an SCLC person about help during the voter registration drive. They might provide some transportation.

They had reservations at the Back Bay Hotel but were told they could not stay there. They then spent the night at the Riviera Hotel in Biloxi, but were told this morning that they would have to leave.

business, the Jasper Lounge, a Cafe, in the afternoon of June 21, in the  
company of two white men. He was found by three children playing in the

and said she didn't know the cause of her jusband's death and that the police
