Windows were broken out of stores. Police handkithinking are goin; through the Negro community with shotgums, but they were unable to teatch up with any of the ricting and looting to prevent it. One fireman is in the hospital as a result of the wiots. A car with five or six whites drove by the perify of Negro community was seet at.

A cross was burned in Cordele, Georgia on Friday night in fron t of the Rib Shaai, a local eatery in the Negro community.

Also a gross-burning in front of Sun & Samua, Local motel where or affiliated people; "TPI reports 16 reports of cross-burnings in southeast Louisiana, also at 11 pm. A Jackson FBI agent reported the cross burning in front of Sun & Sands.
