Holly Springs 8:15 This morning at 8:15 the Dean family came into the office, this is the same family that were put off their farm for attempting to register to vote. Mrs. Dean had been down to the office Friday to ask information about cotton. This morning she was concerned with the death of her husband. He died last night between two thirty and three. From the symptoms she thinks it is poison and wants an autopsy performed. She says that he was perfectly healthy until last evening. Yesterday he went into Waterford where he has some friends, say his father and one of the men who works for the man that put them off their land. He returned home about ten. Before entering the house he vomited. About 2:25 he awoke with a burning in his chest. his wife got up and got him a glass of water. He vomited twice. He coughed for two or three minutes, and then talked for several minutes. His breath was short. Talked about a fellow he met on the street while in town, but before he finished his head jerked three and he was dead. Body is in an ambulance and they will take him to a ~~hospital~~ hospital where an autopsy will be performed. It should take place today. Yesterday was the the first time he had been in town for any length of time.

The Columbus COFO office is going to send a car out to look for them.Call came in at 8:10.Checked all jails and Sheriff's office in Tupelo and Itawamba County, They are not there. The Sheriff in Tupelo says he will call if they are arrested. Holly Springs went out to look for them too. 9:30 Called the Reby residence a few times, His mother said she was expecting him home at about 8:30, said that he was with them tonight, He still is not home.
