Marks ...bail on Albert Harris is \$1500 for peeping. Hazzard, had been in a state hospital before, and allegedly his mother signed a commitment for the hospital again yesterday. and the SHERIFF IS GOING TO KAME HIM DOWN THERE TOMOROW. Sheriff didn't disagree that the bond was exorbitant and ridiculous, and upon the suggestion of Mr. Mier, the sheriff said that he'd dex try to reduce the bail on Harris. Feel that he's at least a little obligated to try and reduce the bond. The original report came from Joe Louis Hall. via Rev. Young. Hazzard has been in there for 3 months.

Marks ..2:30 J.D. Powells, Klondike Abbet, and Alan Goodner were just released on bond about 2 hr. ago. Goodners was an appeal bond. He had been convicted of gambling fine \$100, and his appeal bond was \$200. Powells and Abbets had appeance bond of \$350. Denton, chancellor of the juvenile court will be out of town until tomorrow morning, Mier left his card with them. Their return date on the bonds are March 8, 1965, Circuit Court. Upon talking with Apsay last nite that he had them prepared last nite(the bond forms). It was not necessary to do this, and that they were stalling us. Apsay should be told, and there should be pressure applied so that all of this can be done w/o a lawyer. Next time there will be property bonds posted, and we will have to work on making them accept this. Lesson doesn't have to post a bond, he SHOULD be allowed to be released in the custody of his parents. They have the money for Lesson Abbet, but Mier doesn't think that it should be paid/ Try and keep up the liason with the sherrif. Lawyers have been notified.

McGONN: 5:00; A public Health inspector was in to see the project today. He claims that the project is running a public eating establishment, and that they are taking money from those they feed. Insists that everyone involved with the food get a public health card. Inspector's name is BJ Jenkins. There is a state law stating that a family of four, can in some cases run as a restaurant.

Olive and Collins. The car itself left the road in the attempt and was caught by the traffic and held several car lengths behind the rest of the way back to Jackson. There were 6 or 7 people in the car, one being a small child. Mrs. Henderson of Batesville was with Herring at the time.
