Viva Insurance Cancelled

On September 17 Annie Moore was notified that the policy on his service station was cancelled as of the 22nd.

The notice was a printed form from the Grain Dealers Mutual Insurance Company of Indianapolis, Indiana. No reason was given. The policy was for \$17,000.

Mr. Moore has been a key figure in the registration and voting campaign waged this summer in the Mississippi Delta. His house was headquarters for the Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) director of the campaign.

In the past few weeks there have been a number of violent attacks upon SNCC workers and a bitter newspaper attack upon the SCDF.

We are trying to find a replacement for Mr. Moore's policy. One suggestion has been Lloyd's of England. We are exploring that possibility.

If you knowed any liberal insurance executive of a company licensed to do business in Mississippi, you may wish to try and interest him in this case.

Time is of essence.
