All of them were very interested in what I am doing but feel a little afraid of me because the situation is is as tense here. There are two negre students on the campus for the first time and the students and the faculty are going through an adjustment period.

The administration has its finger in everything to be sure nobedy rocks the beat. The S. C. State Inversigators (SCLED) are all over the campus. They're taking down tag nos. I understand that there are many students working with the administration reporting anything strange. I guess I've been reported by now. I am staying off campus as much as possible and doing most of my work off campus.

There are demonstrations going on every day at the down town theaters and stores. There was a march Sunday on the state capital protesting the B<sup>c</sup>ham bombings. These demonstrations are made of high school kids and even younger. (I don't know how many arrest if any have been made.) I understand the MAACP is giving some leadership to them.

I spent the afternoon talking to students and goeting a list of centacts. I did not go on the campus again because I have been advised not to until I see the dean of students. I am going to try to see him temperrow afternoon. Tenight I spent my time talking to students at the Wesley Foundation. I am staying here at the center.
