9. Did you have any contact with police? Explain. No, except Deputy. told us to get off the pavement & walk on the side.
10. Give your impressions of community, evaluation of your work, what you think can be done.
The Negro community is beginning to get a sense of power if organized. Able leaders emerging. Of course, there is jealousy, lack of experience & fear, but a new sense of freedom. Old Negro spirituals about the other side of the Jordan are replaced by "freedom songs" disturbed by a moral attitudes of many students. They do not see a necessary correlation between social justice & personal ethics.
