When I last talked to him his plans regarding school were indefinite; he may drop out for awhile to work with poor whites through SOCC, or stay in school and split his time between the poor folks and the student milieu. Dave desperatly fleeds assistance, either to defray his traveling expenses or to get drunk once a week. He would be as worthy a recipient as anyone, and I think the prospect of getting letters from a native white boy active in the movement would delight Unitarians. He can be contacted through FIS, Box 120, Tougaloo, Miss. 39174. Let me know if there is any chance of Dave getting funded and I will tell him what is expected of a welfare recipient.
