

WEEKLY REPORT a June 28-July 4, 1964

The Freedom School teachers arrived, and there was both a transportation and a housing problem throughout the week. There was one staff car for fifteen workers, and most of our (VR staff) time was spent shuttling Freedom School teachers around.

There were two mass meetings held during the week, one at St. John's and one at Pleasant Green, which we attended. We canvassed for Freedom Registration at both meetings.

The charges were a) driving a car without a Mississippi inspection sticker, and b) operating with an out-of-state license in a car with a Mississippi tag. The penalty for each charge was \$16. Officer Evans gave Dave the ticket when he had been in Mississippi for 4 days.
