CHECK LIST

Incident: date, time, place : The driver of a truck of library books being shipped from Holly Springs to one of the Freedom Schools in Madison County. The driver, Harry Malm, was arrested about 6:30 PM on charges of "blocking the road". The two state patrolmen who arrested him near Gluckstadt, near Madison, said they were taking Malm to Judge Leroy Hawkins in Madison.

Cause of incident: :
Police: city, county, or state names, badge #'s, car #'s. : Malm was picked up as he turned his truck off the highway to deliver book to the Mt. Pleasant Church near Gluckstadt.

Jail: city or county location charges bond phone : Hi Pat reports he was taken to JP in Madison, then up to Madison County Jail. Jail doesn't have him yet.

Charges are improper parking and improper license (said he should have Miss. license since he had been in the state for over 30 days).
