- 10. Give your impressions of community, evaluation of your work, what you think can be done.
 Negro community still somewhat distrustful of whites
 White community refuse to know what negroes want and need.
 My contribution was small and thus its effect will be small. I came poorly equipped but left with greater understanding.
 One opening I think should be checked into further. That of contacting white families living in the immediate area of the negro community.
 My one experience was very encouraging.
 More time should be spent with those negro families who are receptive 1/2 hr and even longer visits are helpful.
