

INCIDENT SUMMARY

Sunday night, October 4th.--Billy Noble called the Freedom House several times asking for you and asking who was at the Community Center.

Monday night, October 5th.- Three policeman barged past Eartiss James Crawford and entered the Freedom House without a Search Warrant. They entered the bedroom and told George Raymond that they had a warrant for Jim Collier. George immediately had them leave the Freedom House and told them not to come back without a Search Warrant. Tuesday morning George went down and talked to the police concerning this.

Monday afternoon, Oct. 5th.--Miss Catherine Nichols, who had gone downtown to register, was arrested for profanity and released five hours later on a \$25.00 fine. It was a legitimate charge actually. Just before her arrest a man hit George Raymond; when the police came over to inquire what happened, she said "that ~~man~~ hit George Raymond".

At the Courthouse Monday people were turned away and told to come back next week. Some were spoken to in abusive language, aff. and statements are being taken now.

Friday morning at 1:01 a.m., October 2nd., two policemen fired a shot at a dog about 50 feet from the Freedom house and the Community Center. Martha Wright, Tom Ramsay, and myself were sitting in direct line with the darn dog. They missed the dog (animal type) and also the dogs (people type.) The next day I called the police station and spoke ~~to~~ ^{with} Chief Dan Thompson. He told me that police often fire at stray dogs and there was no intention to harm anyone. Since we were hidden by a fence and part of a tree it was left at that.
