We (Phil Sharp and I) promised to come to Sunday service and talk about classes--some interested people. (a Mr. Fleming and Mrs. Brown were two people there). We couldn't make it Sunday--we had only one car and no gas in it--Mr. William's pump not working. Important to keep commitments we make.

In the evening went to mass meeting at New True Light with Charlie and Phil--good meeting--but pretty talkie. Boys off the Meridian for CORE staff meeting--Karen and I ran the office. In the afternoon I went to Community center to work on the library--met some little children who will probably be in school there. Talked with Mrs. Harrison who keeps an eye on things. looks like the library will be a target soon. (if it isn't already). Met a Sam Brown also. Wonder about the distrust people have. Evening the local boys helped us to work on posters for Mrs. Devine's speech tomorrow. James Williams made some good signs for party--he is interested ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ in vocational training schools COFO is helping I hope. Boys left and Karen and I stayed to watch the F.H. Visitor incident--reported to Canton.

Saturday, (17th)

Visit to Mrs. McCullough--planning a dinner. Worked in library all afternoon.
