3. Community Center:

The community center is operated by Nina, in which she also operates a library. Different activities are carried on, such as mass meetings, social games, other organizational meetings. The center is closed at 10:00 every night.

4. Federal programs is operated by Annie Clay. She is now in the process of organizing a farmer's league and is working on getting people ready for the ASC elections.

5. We don't have a freedom school operating on the project now, since children get home from school so late they only have time for their homework.

6. We have committees accross the county that issue the food and clothing by application forms. The committees determine if the family needs the food and clothing, then pack boxes themselves and deliver them to those that do.

7. Voter registration is operated by Annie Hudson and Theodis Hewitt and other NAACP staff. In Harmony, 54 persons were qualified to vote, that didn't in the last election. Across the county, 224 persons qualified to vote in this election. Voter registration meetings are held once a week, along with a work shop.
