Subject: Summary Field Report for the Madison, County area for the period Of Nov. 5, to Nov. 15.

Da vid Dukes a nd I began immediately after election Day to work with the local P.T.A. in tying to change some of the conditions of the negro school which is very poor even in compa rsion with other negro schools in North and south Florida.

We a ttended two School board meetings taking a list of proposals from the steering committee which were sa id to have been taken under careful consideration by members of the board. At this time no consideration has been made by the board to improve these very poor conditions and no father action have been taken by the negro community.

An a nswer to the proposals from the school board members are on file in the **Ce**ntral Office.

At this time w e feel that chances a revery slim for organizing a CORE Chapter in Madison, County, since there is a very active N.A.A.C.P. Chapter already among the youths.

However, since Rev. Jamins on think that there is no need for any more Steering Committee meetings now that Election Day is over and refuse to discuss certa in matters with us, the cooperation of the adults have completely dropped.

The purpose of this meeting, (primarily for adults)can be to secure information on organizing a loca 1 fore Chapter. We persona 11y feel tha this will be a success. This would also renew the old interest in the a dults since the Steering Comm. is no longer functioning in a ny way. This will also give the adults something to continue to do in this great fight for equal opportunities for all.

The registra tion books a re now open on Fridays and Sat. morinings until noon. So fa r, no ca nva ssing ha s been done but leafetts ha ve been distributed in certain areas.

The only real problem is getting the cooperation of the Aegro community. Once this is done, We are sure that action will soring ba ck to life in Ma dison, County.
