You may contact them directly through the xR Freedom School Coordinator there, Mrs. Lee Bankhead, Box 141, Cleveland, Mississippi, and make arrangements with her. Mrs. Bankhead is a local Mississippian, and from what I can see is creating the best Freedom School we have in the state.

Good luck with your adopting! Mrs. Bankhead can tell you about the needs, both for the schools and the community center, and the clothing needs of the community this cold-promising winter in the Delta.
