We have not written to the OEO directly because Marv
Rich suggested that we write to him when I told him what
was going on. The letter you got was a copy of our reply to
his request that we spell out the facts. However, because
we can not document the exclusion of poor whites from the
group it seems that the CORE national office will be unable
to file a complaint with the OEO.

I have very little hope for any complaint that we might file directly from here. A previous letter to the Job Corps (about the fact that different treatment was being given applications sent from the COFO office and those sent from the high school) received no reply whatsoever from Washington, not even the minimal politness of saying that they had received the letter.
