WEEKLY REPORT -- VALLEY VIEW COFO OFFICE -- August 21-27, 1965

Saturday, August 21: I drove Green into Jackson and attended the morning session of the FDP workshop. I then drove a group of people to Madison County and returned to Jackson and brought another group back to Madison County.

I worked on the community center the remainder of the afternoon and attended the community center meeting at night. It was a very good meeting with people attending from a large area.

Thursday, August 26: I worked on the community center for a while, then canvassed for school desegregation on Rick's bicycle.

Friday, August 27: I worked on the community center all day because they were short of help and were having trouble with a warped beam. I caught a ride into Canton at night to pick up mended clothing and was unable to get a ride back, so I stayed at the Canton office overnight.
