Note When the official list of registered voters was published in the newspaper it was broken down as to race, this made it easy to get a comparison of Negro and White voting strength. The official list listed 4,478 White voters and 3,950 Negroes. It should be noted however that the U.S. census (1960) gives the white voting age population as approx. 3,600. Still, even if you removed that 800 or so persons listed who are dead we would then have a ma jority of only 350 votes.
