approx 8:30 A.M.

We (Roosevelt Burnett, Barry Wallace and me) arrived at the voting Place in Beat 3 (Bucksnort Precinct House) to leave of Mrs. Emma Rhynes who was Poll watcher for Beat 3. She went into the voting Place to begin being Poll watcher, she presented her slip ~~to~~ to the official but they told her she could not stay because there was no room and she had to go 30' away. She left the Polling Place and came and talked to us a few

minutes later a federal Poll
watcher came out and I
talked to her and took her
name etc. Then he went in
and talked to the officials. After
a while the officials told
Mrs. Rhynes that she could
come in. While this was
going on there was a group
of white men standing around
writing down our license #
and talking on a radio phone
in a truck. One of these men
(who went in and out of the polling
place at will) ~~later~~ drove off
down the road just B4 we
left toward Greensboro. We
took another route. Later
he showed up in front of our
office. He was driving a

the Polling Place in Beat 9
(John Nolan, Ron Kaufman,
Mack Ford, Roosevelt Burnett and
me) We were talking to the
Poll Worker, Mrs. Violet Lee Parker,
when Two white men, 1 with a
Pistol, came out of the Polling
Place and over to us, also a
white man who ~~at~~ had arrived
in a truck. They asked us what
we were doing and I said
"Talking to our Poll Worker"
He said not to stay to long, (the
one with the gun) the 2 from
The Polling Place went Back
into the Place. The one from
The truck stood right next

He later followed us to Bent
