Dear Don:

I am very grateful for your willingness to try to obtain from the Alabama Department of Education the material which Yale Rabin needs. I am enclosing several letters, which are the last in a long series of exchanges relating to Yale's attempts to inspect information relating to the Lowndes County Title I funds. The information which Yale needs is described in the first paragraph of his letter of November 8: "Copies of the applications (for Title I funds) including full descriptions of the programs approved for the 1965-66 school year and any which has been approved for the 1966-67 school year." I hope that you can arrange to have these documents xeroxed on the premises; if no, perhaps you can persuade the office personnel to make some arrangement at your expense for their reproduction.
