- 1 The poor peoples committee continues ~~nt~~ to meet 6 days a week.
- 2 We are handeling about 6 cases a week -that is they took these people down to the welfare office and helped argue their case.
- 3 We have collected data on about 25 cases to be used in future apeall, statistical breakdwns, and the U.S. Civil Rights Commision hearing in February.
- 4 On Teusday of this week the committee had a meeting with a ~~xxx~~ representative of the Civil Rights Commision and a representative from the Lawyers. The meeting was very sucessfull. Marion was very pleased with the meeting. Some of those at the meeting will be asked to testify at the hearings.
- 5 A number of people will be going to Jackson on the 21st for a meeting of the Co*op group. Hopefully this will begin the formation of the Grenada manufacuting Co-op.
