- 1 The poor peoples committee continues at to meet 6 days a week.
- We are handeling about 6 cases a week -that is they took these people down to the welfare office and helped argue their case.
- 3 We have collected data on about 25 cases to be used in future apeall, statistical breakdowns, and the U.S. Civil Rights Commission hearing in February.
- on Teusday of this week the committee had a meeting with a prerepresentative of the Civil Rights Commision and a representative from the Lawyers. The meeting was very successfull. Marion was very pleased with the meeting. Some of those at the meeting will be asked to testify at the hearings.
