Our candidates for Supervisor in the First, Second, and Third Supervisor's Districts, who are Mr. Jim E. Bobo, Mr. Alfred Welshan and Mr. Max Dilworth, are opposed in the November General Election by independent candidates supported and backed by the Freedom Democratic Party. In addition, State Senator Wm. B. Alexander and State Representative Dana C. Moore, Jr., incumbent candidates for State Senator and State Representative are likewise opposed.

Your Bolivar County Voters League feels that this presents a serious problem for all Bolivar Countians. The election of these independent candidates, who we feel to be completely unqualified for the offices they seek, would seriously disrupt and impair our local government here in Bolivar County. The problem is multiplied by the fact that the people are not accustomed to voting in November. This, plus the recent overwhelming increase in the number of registered voters, makes it mandatory that we all vote on November 7.

May we take this opportunity to urge that you, your families, your neighbors, and your friends be at the polls on November 7, 1967, and vote in order that we may continue to have responsible and stable government in Bolivar County. We also urge that you carry this message to your fellow Bolivar Countians through your civic clubs, churches, and other organizations.
