Below fully sworn deposes and says: To-wit: I am a citizen of the United States of America and am a Negro or a white participant in civil rights and desegregation work. On (day) Monday (month) June, 1964, at about time, the following happened:

I have been working for Dr. and Mrs. Calhoun. On Monday, July 6, I did not go to work as I usually do because my employer said she would not be back from her July 4th vacation until that evening. At about 6 or 6:30 that evening Dr. had a phone call from Mrs. Calhoun. She said that her husband, Dr. Calhoun, had told her she would have to let go of me, for as she knew I was housing two white CORE workers, a Negro and a white girl. She asked why and I told her it was because of the CORE workers. Also when she told me she would let me go she called me an "agitator".
