On the morning of July 8, 1964, I was sleeping in the McComb Freedom House at 702 Wall Street. At about 3:50 a.m. I was awakened by a blast, splinters and debris flying through the air. Our house had been bombed and two of the ten residents, myself and Curtis Hayes, were injured with minor cuts and I recieved a mild concussion. The local police arrived a few minutes after the the bomb went off, and the first on to the scene remarked, "It must have been termites." The police poked around the flower beds and picked up bits of matting which had been blown all over the yard and then left the house. Although the local police, the Pike County Sheriff's office and the F.B.I. have been investigating this, incidents since that time, neither it nor twelve other bombings in the McComb area have been solved.
