I was asleep on the night of July 9, 1964, and was awakened at about 3:45 a.m. by a blast. My windows were falling out and the picture on the wall fell. I knew it was next door at the C.O.F.O. Freedom House. I went to the window to look out and I heard people screaming, "Call the police." I went to the telephone and dialed the operator, because I couldn't think of the number. She gave me the City Hall. A voice answered saying, "Police Department," and I said, "Send the police up here on Wall Street, the house next door was bombed." He only said, "hmm," without asking where it was. I hung up. While I was putting on my house coat and slippers to go next door, the police arrived already. I couldn't have been more than four or five minutes after the blast.
