Being duly sworn deposes and says: to-wit: I am a citizen of the United States of America and am a white participant in civil rights and desegregation work. On Friday, July 10, 1964, at about 3:40 P.M. THE FOLLOWING HAPPENED:

I, Howard Bruce Glushakow, accompanied by Sylvie Woog and Neil Eklund, drove out to the Driver's License Office at Highway Patrol Headquarters on Route 69 out of Columbus, Mississippi. Having received previous to this a traffic ticket because of my out-of-state (New York) license, it was my intention to obtain a Mississippi Driver's License. I went alone into the Driver's License Office where Patrolman J.I. Wofford of the Mississippi Highway Patrol was talking to two young ladies. After a few minutes they ended their conversation and left. I was then alone in the office with Patrolman Wofford. I told him that I desired to obtain a driver's license. He then asked whether I had a valid license. He said "Yes" and handed him my New York License. He looked at the license and asked me where I lived. I told him "1212 17th St. North". He asked me where I worked. I told him I worked with the Council of Federated Organizations. He then handed me back my license. I was a little confused and asked him whether he understood that I wanted a Mississippi license. He said he understood but that "I have no use for you!" I said "I don't care whether or not you have any use for me; your job is to enforce the law." He said, "I am enforcing the law!" I then repeated that I wished to apply for a license. He replied, "Then you'll have to apply somewhere else!" I then left the office and we drove directly to the local FBI Headquarters on Highway 82 in Columbus to make a formal complaint and to ask, if necessary, that an agent of the FBI accompany me back so that I might obtain a license. Unfortunately, no one was in the office when we arrived at 4:00 P.M.
