I went from Columbus to the State Prison at Parchman with the mother of James Edward Jackson. Our purpose in going was to ascertain the details of Jackson's first arrest and subsequent conviction. The facts are: On June 19, 1962 Jackson was arrested for burglary. He pled guilty at the trial and was sentenced to two years at Parchman by presiding Judge Green although City Prosecutor Mr. Soms, Jr. asked for a six year sentence. He was convicted of one count of burglary only. After serving approximately two years, Jackson was sent discharge papers from Jackson M.S. Jackson was discharged on March 12, 1964.
