

Report of Joseph Smith to Ron Ridenour ---- July 23, 1964 - Moss Point

I went to the Jackson County courthouse, July 13 to register to vote, at 12:20. The lady gave me the papers to register. I was still working on them when she came back and began to mark X's on them. The clerks were mumbling about the time being late. I told her I wasn't through and she later gave me the papers back. I began again and again she took them back. I told her I still wasn't through and after a while she again gave them back, I again began to work. Then she took them away saying I didn't pass because I didn't interpret right. But she didn't even look at the papers. I asked when could I try again and she said from 30 to 60 days.
