I am a Negro adult resident of McComb Mississippi. I operate a cafe in McComb Mississippi and serve all customers there regardless of race. That during the summer, 1964, I served civil rights workers both Negro and white who were there, and many who are now in McComb working on voter registration of Negroes there. They have harassed me from time to time by getting phone calls from unknown callers; also moles ed by white persons in McComb.

On Sunday night, September 20, 1964, about 11:00 p.m., while my two children were asleep in the bedroom and a pregnant baby sitter was there, my home was bombed. The bomb tore up my whole house and all the furniture. My two children, luckily, were only slightly injured.
